II. 5th and 7th Commandments = marriage & family the basic building block of a prospering society.

A. 5th: Family as the first line of self-government—inculcating respect for authority & preservation of wealth for family growth.

George Gilder, Wealth and Poverty:

"Civilized society is dependent upon the submission of the short-term sexuality of young men to the extended maternal horizons of women. This is what happens in monogamous marriage; the man disciplines his sexuality and extends it into the future through a woman's womb. The woman gives him access to his children, otherwise forever denied to him; and he gives her the product of his labor, otherwise dissipated on temporary pleasures. The woman gives him a unique link to the future and a vision of it; he gives her faithfulness and a ommitment to a lifetime of hard work. If work effort is the first principle of overcoming poverty, marriage is the prime source of upwardly mobile work."

Parental authority & family inheritance protection

B. 7th: Adultery as a violence of the core of the family structure

"Relationship" in the Bible vs. contemporary culture; contracts & relationships

Num 30:2: "If a man vow a vow unto the LORD, or swear an oath to bind his soul with a bond; he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceedeth out of his mouth"

<u>Principle</u>: Dysfunctional families create a "vacuum" into which intrudes the State as the New Parent; conversely, strong families are the fundamental mainstay against tyranny. Remember God called Abraham and his family out of a pagan tyranny to start all over.

III. 6^{th} Commandment = centerpiece of the Kingdom of God is the creature made in His image.

Deut 21:1-9 value of the life lost

The end of all labor isn't material wealth; it is more life—more godly children, more time for enjoying God's glory and helping others toward that goal.

IV. The link between our labor and the labor of the Lord Jesus Christ

- A. <u>Jesus' Labor on earth</u>—conformity to the principles of human labor & reward → validates the dynamics of our labor (Heb. 2:10; 5:8; John 4:34; 9:4; 17:4; 19:26-27,30.
- B. <u>Jesus' Reward in heaven</u>—final "pricing" fits the "value" because the Father makes clear the **true value**—not a pseudo-divine Marxist bureaucrat with a finite and arrogant mind-set coming up with a "fair price". **Heb 1:4**.
