subjective feeling = opinion ==> no objective evil? can't be lived out! ==> totalitarian-imposed ethics

EPISTEMOLOGY--how do I know something is true including what you are telling me? subjective feeling = opinion ==> all conversation is merely autobiography, including your ideas about relativism
