Confidence Breakthrough (Ps 59:8-10) – Assurance that God will answer

Detailed Petition (Ps 59:11-15) – Specific requests for verification that God has answered

Praise Vow (Ps 59:16-17) – Linkage with God's glory

Our Deepest Heart-Mind

"He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end" (Ecc 3:11)

"what can be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them, for since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse" (Rom 1:19–20)

Our "Avoidance" Urge
