

Examples of God's "Sacred Spaces"

"The Angel of the LORD appeared to [Moses]... called to him from the midst of the burning bush. ... 'Do not draw near to this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground' " (Ex 3:2–5)

"All the people witnessed the thundering, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking. ... Then they said to Moses, 'You speak with us, and we will hear, but let not God speak with us lest we die.' " (Ex 20:18–19)

"Moses finished the work. Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter. ..." (Ex 40:34–35)



"Full View" Incarnation

"The Son of Man . . . His head and hair were white like wool . . . His eyes a flame of fire . . . feet like fine brass . . . His voice as the sound of many waters . . . out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword . . . His countenance like the sun shining in its strength . . . When I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead." (Rev 1:13–17)



Jesus in His Human Nature Had to be Sanctified

"Though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered . . . For it was fitting for Him for whom are all things and by whom are all things . . . to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings." (Heb 5:8; 2:10)



God's Righteousness Incentivizes Self-Examination & Confession

"This is the message which we have heard from Him . . . that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth." (1 John 1:5–6)
